ORDINANCE NO. 2024- 05

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MARTIN COUNTY TRAFFIC SAFETY ENFORCEMENT FUND

WHEREAS, there has been a grant made by The Indiana Criminal Justice Institute to the Martin County Sheriff's Department to be utilized for the purpose of enforcement of Indiana statutes regarding school bus stop arm violations, OVWI traffic stops, and other traffic safety matters; and

WHEREAS, the Indiana State Board of Accounts has stated that the governing body of a political entity must adopt in a public meeting an ordinance establishing a specific fund, and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of Martin County Indiana, as follows:

- 1. That the Martin County Stop Arm Violation Enforcement Fund, Fund Number **9118** was previously established as part of the Martin County General Fund.
- 2. That the Martin County Stop Arm Violation Enforcement Fund shall hereafter be named the Martin County Traffic Safety Fund.
- 3. That the Martin County Auditor shall deposit all grant funds paid by The Indiana Criminal Justice Institute to Martin County for school bus stop arm violations, OVWI traffic stops, and other traffic safety matter enforcement activities into said Martin County Traffic Safety Fund and a claim created against said Fund for the full reimbursement amount.
- 4. That the money receipted into said Martin County Traffic Safety Fund, Fund Number 9118 shall be receipted into Martin County General Fund.
- 5. That following receipt into the County General Fund, all normal appropriation procedures shall apply toward said funds.
