Ordinance 2020- /6

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #2009-12 TO RECQUIRE REAL ESTATE OWNERS TO ENSURE THAT ANY TRANSIENT MERCHANT CONDUCTING BUSINESS ON AN OWNER'S REAL ESTATE MUST POSSESS A VALID TML ISSUED BY PARKE COUNTY

WHEREAS, Ordinance #2009-12 requires that any Transient Merchant conducting business in Parke County, Indiana must have a valid TML issued by the Parke County Auditor's Office and;

WHEREAS, property owners are in a better position to ensure Transient Merchants that are conducting business on said property owner's property hold a validly issued TML and;

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners have determined that a penalty should be imposed for a property owner's failure to ensure a Transient Merchant that is conducting business on said property owner's property possesses a validly issued TML prior to conducting business and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Parke County, Indiana that:

- 1. The penalty for a property owner's failure to ensure that any Transient Merchant that is conducting business on said property owner's property has a validly issued TML prior to conducting business shall be a fine of \$500, said fine shall be imposed per occurrence per day (i.e. every separate violation on every separate day shall result in a separate \$500 fine);
- 2. That in all other respects Ordinance #2009-12 shall remain in full force except as specifically amended herein.
