NIGH ADVISED THE HOMEOWNER WAS FINE WITH IT HE JUST NEEDED TO KNOW IT.

MIKE OBGERFELL / USI:

KEVIN WANTED TO CONGRATULATE USI WAS AWARDED THE STATE FINALIST AWARD FOR THE ENGINEERING EXCELLENCE ON BRIDGE #13.

MIKE ADVISED THEY HAVE 4 OF THE 5 COMMUNITY CROSSING GRANT PROJECTS BID OUT AND AWARDED AND CONSTRUCTION SHOULD BE STARTING VERY SOON ON THESE. BRIDGE #10, #12, #32, #133 AND THE REPAVING OF 400 N. SINCE THE PRICING CAME IN UNDER ON SOME OF THE JOBS AND OVERAGES ON SOME OF THE JOBS, WE NEED TO MODIFY THE AUTHORIZATION TO PROCEED ON THESE

5 JOBS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$13,304.00 GOING BACK TO THE COUNTY. MOTION TO APPROVE WAS MADE BY ROSS, SECONDED BY PARKER, APPROVED 3-0

WE STILL HAVE BRIDGE #32 WE SUBMITTED FOR COMMUNITY CROSSING FUNDS IN JANUARY AND THEY SHOULD BE AWARDING THAT EARLY NEXT MONTH. SO HOPEFULLY THAT GETS FUNDED AND THEN THERE WAS ANOTHER ROAD PAVING ON MICHIGAN ROAD FUNDING AND WE STILL HAVE BRIDGE #28 ON 350 N AND BRIDGE #9 ON 600 W SOUTH OF NEW PAL THAT ARE IN THE DESIGN PHASE, WE ARE PUSHING BRIDGE #9 NOW BECAUSE OF THE CONDITION IT IS IN THIS WOULD BE THE NEXT OPPORTUNITY TO GO FOR COMMUNITY CROSSING WILL PROBABLY BE NEXT JANUARY IF YOU GET MONEY FROM THIS JANUARY AND BY THEN WE SHOULD HAVE BRIDGE #9 READY. IT TAKES A YEAR TO YEAR IN A HALF FOR DNR PERMITS. THIS WAS INFORMATION ONLY; NO ACTION WAS NEEDED AT THIS TIME.

MICHELLE MILLER / 300 N TRAFFIC:

MICHELLE MILLER A RESIDENT ON 300 N BY POET SAID SHE HAD EMAILED KEVIN AND HADN'T RECEIVED A RESPONSE. NIGH ADVISED HE HAD RESPONDED TO IT ON TUESDAY, SHE SAID SHE NEVER RECEIVED IT. MICHELLE HAS SAFETY CONCERNS OF THE TRAFFIC THAT GOES BY HER HOUSE AND WOULD LIKE TO SEE THE SPEED REDUCED AND THE TRAFFIC REDIRECTED TO GO OUT AND BACK IN OFF OF 400 N USING TOM HESSION DR TO COME IN. IT WILL BE HARD TO GET THE SEMIS TO DIVERT, THEY REALLY DON'T HAVE ANOTHER WAY IN WITHOUT GOING BACK TO LONDON ROAD AND BACK IN. NIGH ADVISED HE SPENT TIME OUT THERE LAST WEEK AND WATCHED AND FOLLOWED SOME OF THE TRAFFIC. NIGH ADVISED THAT THERE WERE A COUPLE DAYS THAT IT WAS BUSY BECAUSE POET WANTED TO FILL THE BINS SO THEY REALLY PUSHED FOR PEOPLE TO COME IN. NIGH ALSO ADVISED HE REALLY DIDN'T SEE A PROBLEM WITH THE SPEED AND REALLY COULDN'T TELL WHERE THE SEMIS HAD ENOUGH ROOM BETWEEN THE RAILROAD AND POET TO PICK UP LOTS OF SPEED. MICHELLE SAID THE TRAFFIC HASN'T SLOWED DOWN AND THE SEMIS ARE USING THEIR JAKE BRAKE FROM STOPPING AND IT IS VERY LOUD. SHE WOULD JUST LIKE SIGNS TO DIVERT THE TRUCKS. ROSS ADVISED YOU ARE GOING TO HAVE GRAIN TRUCKS. NIGH ADVISED THEY COULD DO A TRAFFIC STUDY, BUT SHE WOULD BE SURPRISED AT THE SPEEDS, THEY WON'T BE AS FAST AS SHE THINKS. SHERIFF ADVISED THAT POET IS PUTTING A SIGN UP AT THE ROAD RECOMMENDED THE DRIVERS TURN RIGHT AND USE TOM HESSION ROAD AND EVEN PUTTING IT ON THEIR TICKETS, SO POET IS TRYING TO HELP. NIGH ASKED THAT THEY LET THEM DO THE STUDY AND COME UP WITH NUMBERS. MILLER ASKED HOW SOON THIS COULD BE DONE. THE SHERIFF ADVISED HE COULD HAVE IT SET SOMETIME THE BEGINNING OF NEXT WEEK. PARKER ADVISED HE THINKS ONCE THAT JOHNSON COUNTY FINISHES THE 400 N PROJECT THIS WILL TAKE CARE OF THE PROBLEM, IT MAY BE A COUPLE YEARS, BUT IT SHOULD FIX IT. NO ACTION WAS NEEDED.
