ALLISON BORDEAUX, JENNIFER WEIMER, AND DEVON JONES WITH GALLAHUE COMMUNITY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH, PRESENTED THE COMMISSIONERS WITH THEIR ANNUAL UPDATE. THEY HANDED OUT PACKETS WITH INFORMATION WITH STATISTICS. TOTAL PEOPLE SEEN THIS YEAR SO FAR 977 ADULTS, 260 YOUTH, SERVICES HAVE BEEN FOR MENTAL HEALTH, ADDICTION TREATMENTS. THEY WENT OVER SOME OF THE PROGRAMS THEY HAVE BEEN RUNNING. THE JAIL INTERVENTION PROGRAM (JIP). THEY EXPRESSED OVERALL PATIENTS' EXPERIENCES BASED ON THEIR SURVEYS HAVE BEEN OVERALL SATISFIED WITH THEIR PROGRAMS AND HELP. THEY ADVISED THE TOP FIVE ADDICTION SUBSTANCES ARE ALCOHOL, STIMULANTS, OPIOID, CANNABIS AND GENERAL SUD. THIS WAS INFORMATION ONLY; NO ACTION WAS NEEDED.
