

The Shelby County Commissioners met on Monday August 7, 2023, at 8:00 a.m., present were Commissioners Nigh, Parker, Abel, County Attorney and County Auditor.

MINUTES:

Motion to approve July 31, 2023, minutes was made by Nigh, seconded by Abel, approved 3-0.

RESOLUTION / HEALTH DEPT. SENATE BILL 4:

Robert Lewis presented the Commissioners with Resolution 2023-9. This Resolution allows Shelby County to opt into the State Public Health Department Funding. Motion to approve Resolution 2023-9 was made by Abel, seconded by Nigh, approved 3-0.

PLAN COMMISSION / REZONES :

Desiree presented the Commissioners with three rezone recommendations.

1. Ham rezone located at 8800 S 600 W, Edinburgh, this was heard at the July 25, 2023, meeting and voted 6-0 to forward to the County Commissioners for approval. They are requesting to rezone 3 acres from RE to R1 to allow for a 2-lot simple subdivision. Motion to approve Ordinance 2023-25 was made by Nigh, seconded by Abel, approved 3-0.
2. Cook rezone located at east side of S. Edinburgh Rd, between 900 S & 1000 S, Jackson Township, this was heard at the July 25, 2023, meeting and voted 6-0 to forward to the County Commissioners for approval. They are requesting to rezone 3.675 acres from A1 to RE. Motion to approve Ordinance 2023-26 was made by Abel, seconded by Nigh, approved 3-0.
3. Voegel rezone located at 5250 N Morristown Rd, Marion Township, this was heard at the July 25, 2023, meeting and voted 6-0 to forward to the County Commissioners for approval. They are requesting to rezone 4.1 acres from A2 to RE to allow for a 2-lot simple subdivision. Motion to approve Ordinance 2023-27 was made by Nigh, seconded by Abel, approved 3-0.
