

ORDINANCE NO. 2001-

AN ORDINANCE OF THE SHELBY COUNTY COUNCIL,  
SHELBY COUNTY, INDIANA REQUIRING THE  
PAYMENT OF PROPERTY TAXES IN ONE  
INSTALLMENT PURSUANT TO I.C. 6-1.1-22-9

WHEREAS, the Shelby County Council now finds that it is in the best interest of Shelby County, Indiana, to require a person to pay his or her property tax liability in one (1) installment if the tax liability for a particular year is less than twenty-five dollars (\$25); and

WHEREAS, the Shelby County Council now finds that it is in the best interest of Shelby County, Indiana, to require that property tax liability of less than twenty-five dollars (\$25) be due in one (1) installment on May 10 of that year; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF SHELBY, as follows:

Any person who has a property tax liability for a particular year of less than twenty-five dollars (\$25) shall be required to pay said property tax liability in one (1) installment on May 10 of that year, pursuant to I.C. 6-1.1-22-9.
