

RESOLUTION NO. 2009- 04

A RESOLUTION OF THE SHELBY COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD OF SHELBY COUNTY, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Shelby County Drainage Board of Shelby County, Indiana, now finds that the necessity exists for the construction of a new legal drain for the purpose of assisting the residents and surrounding landowners of the Dwain Village Subdivision with ongoing drainage problems; and


WHEREAS, the costs of constructing the Dwain Village Legal Drain is an amount that may be conveniently paid for by owners of land who benefit from the legal drain and who may be assessed to pay for the costs of construction in installments over a five (5) year period; and

WHEREAS, the Shelby County Drainage Board believes it is necessary and appropriate pursuant to I.C. 36-9-27-97.5 to ask the Shelby County Council to obtain a loan for the costs of constructing the Dwain Village Legal Drain.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE DRAINAGE BOARD OF THE COUNTY OF SHELBY, as follows:

The Shelby County Drainage Board now finds that the necessity exists for the construction of the Dwain Village Legal Drain for the purpose of assisting the residents and surrounding landowners of the Dwain Village Subdivision with ongoing drainage problems. The cost of constructing the Dwain Village Legal Drain is an amount that may be conveniently paid for by the owners of land who benefit from the legal drain by assessment for the costs of construction in installments over a five (5) year period. The Shelby County Drainage Board requests the Shelby County Council to obtain a loan for the costs of constructing the Dwain Village Legal Drain.




