**ORDER PROHIBITING DISCLOSURE OF EVICTION RECORDS**

The Court having seen and considered the tenant/defendant's request for non-disclosure. The court being duly advised in the premises, now finds as follows:

This case was either dismissed or resulted in a judgment on behalf of the tenant. No monetary judgment is outstanding to the landlord in this case.

Therefore, it is hereby ordered pursuant to Indiana Code 31-32-11-3 et seq that any records of this action, including the petition by the landlord for possession of the rental unit, shall be permanently sealed. No records related to this eviction action may be disclosed or permitted to be disclosed to any person except by court order. However, absent a court order it is permissible to disclose the records of this action to a law enforcement agency for an authorized law enforcement activity. It is also permissible to disclose these records if authorized under Indiana Code 32-31-11 or as otherwise permitted by law without court order.
