

Joint Commissioner/Council Insurance Committee Meeting  
March 19, 2019

Meeting was called to order by Blake Bunner at 6:30 P.M.

Pete Franzman, Dana Franzman and Carolyn Beck informed the new council members of the basics of the health insurance program.

Kelly Tucker from TrueScripts introduced the employees benefits plan and gave a short overview of the prescriptions and comparison costs for the years 2016, 2017, and 2018. This also included the cost savings of the mail order drugs.

She also explained when the county retains the rebates from a drug, the county receives 100% of the rebate.

Dana Franzman introduced the Self-Funding 101 and went over the advantages of self-funding and stop-loss coverage. She also covered the third-party administrator. Reinsurance definitions were also covered.


Pete Franzman covered the Executive summary and discussed the monthly expense report from August 2018-February 2019.

Benton made a motion to adjourn. Bunner seconded the motion, motion was approved. Meeting was adjourned at 7:45 P.M.


