Surveyors Report



He states that he asked for approval to begin the multiple steps to declare a portion of Muddy Creek a regulated drain which included a study by Midwestern engineers. This would determine acreage, parcels, parcel owners and size of parcels which is in the works now. Faulkenberg states he did not request the commissioners to make it a regulated drain but only to start the process. Commissioners acknowledged and accepted the request.

Faulkenberg requested to postpone the awarding of the IRA Tower Drain do to the need of rewriting the bid specifications. Seiler made a motion to approve the bid opening on September 3rd, 2019. Logsdon seconded the motion, motion was approved.

Faulkenberg requests that bids specifications be sent out regarding the flooding from the fire station traffic light at highway 66 to highway 161 for clearing of the ditch.
