Surveyors Report

Surveyor reports all assessments are complete on each parcel within the three existing watersheds, Baker Creek, Hooppole and Huffman. A public hearing was held and all approved. Surveyor states the new Muddy Creek Watershed, which includes, extending Lang & Ray regulated drain 8,736 feet to its discharge point into Pigeon Creek. Public hearing was held on the extension of said drain and all approvals have been met. Surveyor reports notifications have been sent to all parcel owners within the Muddy Creek Watershed with a public hearing set for February 6th, 2020 at 6:00P.M. at the Spencer County Courthouse.

Surveyor states the office received an invoice from Aigner Construction for the removal of four log jams on Pigeon Creek. The total of the invoice was \$1,190.00. Spencer County's portion being \$595.00. Proper procedure was not followed by landowners and Aigner Construction, which caused Warrick County to not participate. Surveyor recommends that Spencer County participate with paying half of the invoice at \$595.00. Logsdon made a motion to approve the \$595.00 being paid to Aigner Construction. Seiler seconded the motion, motion approved.

Surveyor reports the ditch maintenance as follows:

5,700 feet Baker Creek (McCoy) 3,200 feet Ira Tower Hooppole from Hwy 66 Eastward to its beginning 11,500 feet 3,000 feet Huffman Phase 1 (in process) 2,797feet Huffman Reo lateral (in process)

John Ketcham comes before the board stating Garrett Creek has four log jams between 150S and Hwy 45. Ketcham states with the log jams it causes his property to flood. He is requesting the Surveyor have someone removes the jams. Surveyor states he will look into the problem.
