**Surveyors Report**


Faulkenberg reported a public hearing was held on February 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020 concerning the approval of the ne Muddy Creek Watershed. Four citizens were in attendance. After an extensive explanation of the process and benefits to landowners, approval was met by all attending the hearing. Faulkenberg states there was a letter of dissent received from Mr. Gaesser who lives in Pensacola, Florida. Gaesser owns 460 acres of the total of 2,859 acres within the watershed which is 16% of the entire watershed. Faulkenberg states he has an on going dialogue with Mr. Gaesser.


