

**Drainage Board Meeting**

**Minutes**

Brown made a motion to approve the minutes from August 6<sup>th</sup>, 2019 as presented. Logsdon seconded the motion, motion was approved.

**IRA Tower Drain/Bid Opening**

Laswell Excavating \$31,200.00

Gruber Industries, LLC \$46,400.00

Herron Excavating \$22,880.00

Logsdon made a motion to accept bid as presented from Herron Excavating for \$22,880.00.

Seiler seconded the motion, motion was approved.

**Huffman Drain/Bid Opening**

Herron Excavating \$30,767.00

Gruber Industries, LLC \$40,556.00

Seiler made a motion to reject bids because the bids are over budget and to re-bid Huffman Drain. Logsdon seconded the motion, motion was approved. Attorney Lindsey states that with this being re-bid it's like a new bid and other individuals can bid.

**Surveyors Report**

Surveyor reports that Midwestern has information for the new watershed. A meeting has been set for September 27, 2019.

IDEM has inspected jams near the Blue Bridge where timber mats are the cause of jamming the creek. The hope is that we can get into this area while Marathon is removing the timber mats.

Otherwise we will have to obtain a permit which requires mitigation which means the county could have to buy ground to mitigate damage to wetlands.

Surveyor reports that 90% of the ditch spraying is complete.

Logsdon made a motion to adjourn. Brown seconded the motion, motion approved.
