Minutes

Surveyors Report

The Elijah Hatfield Drain project (Baker Creek Watershed) will be delayed until fall as the crops have been planted directly south of the ditch.

Caney Creek Watershed is in the process of development. Assessment will be \$2.00 per acre and \$5.00 for parcels of two (2) acres or less.

Midwestern Engineering is working on the next watershed which will be Big Sandy Watershed. Approximately five (5) miles of new regulated drain will be necessary to be established to form this watershed as there is no discharge point for the existing regulated drain.

A review of balances in Spencer County Regulated Drain Accounts are as follows:
