**Surveyors Report**

JB Chrisney Watershed startup funding request will be made at the July 20, 2021, County Council meeting.

Caney Creek Watershed information is completed. Letters to all parcel owners are completed and to be mailed on July 14, 2021, and the public hearing is scheduled for August 19, 2021, at 6:00 P.M. here at the Courthouse. There are 110 parcels yielding \$8,823.95 annually.


Big Sandy Watershed information is currently with Midwestern Engineers. Approximately six (6) miles of the Big Sandy Creek will be required to be added to the regulated drain inventory before a watershed can be established. Big Sandy discharges into the Ohio River in Grandview. All parcel owners within the drainage area of the newly established regulated drain are to be notified and a subsequent public hearing is to be held.

It is possible to conduct the hearing for the newly established regulated drain and the watershed at the same time as it will involve the same landowners.

Spring Collections were collected and reported for the following watersheds:



Huffman Watershed	\$ 9,768.31
JC Haines (Hooppole) Watershed	\$ 6,426.60
Baker Creek Watershed	\$12,311.15
Muddy Creek Watershed	\$ 4,079.72
