Surveyors Report

Surveyor presents the Muddy Creek Assessment which requires the signature of the Drainage Board. Assessment was signed at previous meeting but the surveyor needs an additional copy.

Faulkenberg states approximately six miles of the Anderson River Project is cleared of 12-15 log jams. Lechner Construction estimated the cost to be approximately \$3,500.00. Seven landowners including three Perry County landowners agreed to 50% participation. No invoice has been received at this time.

Surveyor is currently in the process of preparing bid specifications for approximately 7,145 feet for clearing of Muddy Creek. The project starts at it's discharge in to Pigeon Creek and advancing SE to County Road 750W.

Bid specifications are currently being prepared for Elijah Hatfield Drain. Starting at intersection of county road 850W proceeding NE to county road 200N.

Logsdon made a motion to approve both Muddy Creek and Elijah Hatfield Drain projects. Seiler seconded the motion, motion approved.
