SPENCER COUNTY ELECTION BOARD MEETING

Wednesday, August 17, 2022, 9:45 am Voters Registration Office, Courthouse

Meeting called to order by President Jeff Lindsey. Also present board members Gina Pennington and Clerk Darrell Stephens.

Minutes from July 19, 2022 meeting approved on motion from Gina Pennington and second by Darrell Stephens. Passed with 3-0 vote.

OLD BUSINESS

<u>Internet at Grandview</u>-Stephens advised the board that Eck-Mundy had checked into internet at the Grandview Civic Center and thinks that if PSCI has not installed internet by the November election the possibility to install a temporary remote would provide adequate coverage to get through election day.

High speed printers-Stephens informed the board that 10 high speed printers had been ordered from MicrVote.

<u>Campaign sign laws</u>-President Lindsey discussed laws regulating placing of campaign signs. Lindsey informed the board that there were few restrictions as to when and for how long a candidate might have signs out.

NEW BUSINESS

<u>IVRA Conference</u>-Stephens advised the board that he and VR Officer Sandy Wilkinson had attended the IVRA (Indiana Voter's Registration Association) conference in Noblesville on August 9-10.

<u>Poll Worker Staffing</u>-Poll worker staffing was discussed. Stephens said that numbers would be complete by Friday and forwarded to the county party chairs so they could start recruiting workers. Early Voting begins October 12th.

<u>School Voter Registration</u>-Stephens advised that Wilkinson was working with Heritage Hills and South Spencer regarding fall voter registration at the High Schools. Both schools had expressed interest in incorporating registration into the class room schedule.

<u>Rockport redistricting</u>-Stephens advised the board that he had taken information to the City regarding redistricting and deadlines and dates as discussed at the IVRA conference. Questions arose about past annexations in Dale and whether changes had been made to reflect those annexations. Stephens was asked to look into those.

The next meeting date was set for Wednesday, September 14th at 10:00 a.m. in the Commissioners Room at the courthouse.

Pennington made motion to adjourn meeting, Stephens seconded. All voted in favor.
