

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 85- 10 , 2007

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC ON COUNTY HIGHWAYS
AMENDING GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 85-9, 2007

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, may adopt ordinances regulating traffic on any highway in the county highway system, subject to I.C. 9-21.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that commercial motor vehicles (as defined in I.C. 9-13-2-31) should not be permitted on County Road 800 North between County Road 100 East and County Road 300 East, in Wabash County, Indiana.


WHEREAS, it has been determined that commercial motor vehicles (as defined in I.C. 9-13-2-31) should not be permitted on County Road 300 East between U.S. 24 and County Road 800 North, in Wabash County, Indiana.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS NOW ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:


1. Commercial motor vehicles (as defined in I.C. 9-13-2-31) are prohibited on County Road 800 North between County Road 100 East and County Road 300 East, in Wabash County, Indiana.
2. Commercial motor vehicles (as defined in I.C. 9-13-2-31) are prohibited on County Road 300 East between U.S. 24 and County Road 800 North, in Wabash County, Indiana.
3. Any person or entity that violates any portion of this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction.
