

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 2005 - I

AN ORDINANCE CREATING, AMENDING A SPEED ZONE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code: 8-17-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code: 9-4-1-1 et seq, and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;


WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana has determined that it would be in the best interest of the general public to cause to be established and/or modified, a speed zone from the intersection of Highway 115 and old Highway 24 W to 500 feet west of the entrance to Wabash Alloys factory, a zone wherein the maximum speed for vehicular traffic would be thirty-five miles per hour (35 mph);

NOW THEREFORE, from and after the advertisement and erection of appropriate signs, the maximum speed limit shall be thirty-five miles per hour (35 mph) from the intersection of Highway 115 and old Highway 24 W to 500 feet west of the entrance to Wabash Alloys.

Any person who violates any portion of this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "B" misdemeanor.
