GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 85-4, 2009

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC ON COUNTY HIGHWAYS
(Higley Curve speed limit)


WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, may adopt ordinances regulating traffic on any highway in the county highway system, subject to I.C. 9-21.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, have determined that the speed limit at Higley Curve on Old Highway 24 should be reduced to 45 miles per hour.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The speed limit on Old Highway 24 from seven hundred feet (700') west of County Road 530 West to one thousand eight hundred feet (1800') east of County Road 700 West (a distance of approximately six thousand five hundred feet (6500')) shall be forty-five (45) miles per hour.
2. Any person who violates this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction.
3. The Wabash County Highway Department shall install appropriate signs in accordance with this Ordinance.




