

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 2002-III-A

GENERAL ORDINANCE FOR CLOSING UNIMPROVED COUNTY ROADWAYS


BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana statutes and after thorough and complete investigation, examination, advertised notice, joining owners notice and public hearing, that the following unimproved/unmaintained county roadways shall be closed and not open to any manner or method of transportation:

1. CR 450W, starting at CR 1300N and continuing in a northerly direction terminating at CR 1400N;
2. CR 850N starting at CR 500W (SR 15) and continuing in a westerly direction terminating at 600W;
3. CR 650 W starting at CR 1050N (Woodring Road) continuing in a southerly direction terminating approximately 2100 feet;
4. CR 750W continuing South from section line, which would be CR 1300N terminating at SR 114;
5. CR 1300N starting at Bonestead Road and continuing in a westerly direction to CR 700W;
6. CR 1460N starting at CR 300W and continuing in a westerly direction to the intersection of CR 400W.


The effect of this Ordinance shall be to close all methods of transportation on the above-referenced County Roads.

PASSED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, this 11th day of March, 2002.


