## ORDINANCE NO. 90-II

## AMENDED ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ENHANCED 9-1-1 SERVICE

## FOR THE CITIZENS WITHIN THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE

## COUNTY OF WABASH

WHEREAS, the Wabash County Council and the Wabash County Commissioners approved Ordinance No. 90-II in July and August, 1990, establishing enhanced 9-1-1 service for the citizens within the corporate boundaries of the County of Wabash; and

WHEREAS, in Section 3 of said ordinance, the monthly service fee per telephone access line was set at eighty cents (\$0.80) per telephone access line assessed against all access lines of the telephone subscribers in the service area covered by the 9-1-1 system; and

WHEREAS, the costs of maintaining and operating this system have increased dramatically; and

WHEREAS, I. C. 36-8-16-7 provides for a change in the amount of fee assessed for the 9-1-1 service to be adopted by the County Council; and

WHEREAS, it is determined by the Wabash County Council and the Wabash County Commissioners that it is in the best interest of all residents of Wabash County that the fee for the 9-1-1 emergency service be increased.

NOW, THEREFORE, after careful study and consideration and unanimous vote of all members of the Wabash County Council and the Wabash County Commissioners, Ordinance No. 90-II is hereby amended in Section 3 to increase the monthly service fee per telephone access line from the original Eighty Cents (\$0.80) per telephone access line per month to Two Dollars (\$2.00) per telephone access line per month assessed against all access lines of the telephone subscribers in the service area covered by the 9-1-1 system in Wabash County, Indiana. Said Section 3 of Ordinance No. 90-II shall henceforth read as follows:

A monthly service fee per telephone access line will be collected by the service supplier to pay for the lease, purchase or maintenance of the 9-1-1 system, including necessary computer hardware, software and data base provisioning, and the rates associated with the service supplier's enhanced emergency telephone network service. Said fee is established at the rate of Two Dollars (\$2.00) per telephone access line per month and will be assessed against all access lines of the telephone subscribers in the service area covered by the 9-1-1 system.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all other sections of Ordinance 90-II of the County of Wabash, State of Indiana, be reaffirmed without any changes or modifications.

This said amended ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after it's passage according to law.
