

AMENDED GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 94-5

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING INMATE MEDICAL CO-PAYMENTS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, by amendment to General Ordinance 94-5, under authority of Indiana Code 11-12-5-5 (b), as follows:


WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, are informed of their right by the statute as referred to hereinabove, to increase inmate medical co-payments during the time of their incarceration in the Wabash County Jail from Ten Dollars (\$10) to Fifteen Dollars (\$15); and


NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, as signed hereunder, do hereby accept and approve participation by Wabash County, through the Wabash County Sheriff's Department, in the Inmate Medical Co-Payment Plan outlined and established and at the maximum amount as shown in Indiana Code 11-12-5-5 (b).


FURTHER, the Wabash County Sheriff's Department is directed to implement this program on the earliest effective beginning date.
