GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 2001-2

COUNTY ROAD SIGN ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under the authority of Indiana Code 8-17-1-1 et, seq, and Indiana Code 9-4-1-1 et. seq. and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that there is a need for a sign at 300E from Highway 24 that prohibits commercial traffic to Lagro City Limits .


WHEREAS, it has been determined that the County of Wabash shall be responsible for the placement of the signs.

NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, commercial traffic shall be prohibited on County Road 300E from US Highway 24 to the Lagro City Limits.


Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction.


