2000 IV APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, Wabash County, Indiana is a county organized and existing under the provisions of IC 36-2; and

WHEREAS, the County Council finds that the present facilities of the County Courthouse are not adequate to provide for the proper services to County residents; and

WHEREAS, the County Council has determined to issue bonds of the County in an amount not exceeding Two Million Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$2,250,000) for the purpose of procuring funds to be applied on the purchase of real estate and preliminary costs of construction of an addition to and renovation of the Wabash County Courthouse Annex in said County (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, notice of the determination to issue said bonds has been published; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the Project at the present time is in the approximate amount of Two Million Five Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$2,250,000) and the County Council finds that no provision has been made on account thereof in the existing budget; that an extraordinary emergency exists for the making of an additional appropriation for such purpose; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Council of Wabash County, Indiana that an appropriation of the proceeds of the General Obligation Bonds of 2000 in the amount of Two Million Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$2,250,000) be and the same is hereby made to be applied on the cost of the Project, said appropriation to include the incidental expenses necessary to be incurred in connection with the Project and the issuance of bonds on account thereof; that said appropriation shall be in addition to all appropriations provided for in the existing budget, and shall continue in effect until the completion of the Project.
