

WABASH COUNTY ORDINANCE NUMBER 98-2

AN ORDINANCE TO RE-DEFINE TOWNSHIP PRECINCT BOUNDARIES IN WABASH COUNTY, INDIANA.

WHEREAS, Wabash County Board of Commissioners has the power to re-align election precinct boundaries under state law;

WHEREAS, the Wabash County Board of Commissioners has ordered precinct changes to comply with the annexations that have taken place in the City of Wabash and the Town of North Manchester and to comply with the new law relating to the maximum number of voters required within a precinct.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

- SECTION 1: The precinct Townships of Chester 1, Chester 3, Chester 5, Chester 6, Lagro 1, Lagro 2, Lagro 3, Paw Paw, Pleasant, Waltz, Noble 1, Noble 2, Noble 4, Noble 5, Noble 7, Liberty 1, Liberty 2, whose precinct boundaries are identical to the boundaries of their respective townships shall remain unchanged;
- SECTION 2: The territory of the affected townships of Chester 2, Chester 4, Noble 3, Noble 3A, Noble 6, Noble 8, Noble 9, Noble 10, Noble 10A, and Noble 11 is hereby defined by both legal description and census blocks as indicated by order of the Wabash County Board of Commissioners, attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance.
- SECTION 3: All related ordinances are hereby amended to reflect these precinct changes.
- SECTION 4: Unless otherwise stated, the description of the boundary lines used herein to delineate precincts shall follow the center line of all right-of-ways.
- SECTION 5: In the event any provision of this ordinance be held invalid, all other provisions contained herein shall be considered valid and remain in effect.
- SECTION 6: Whenever the legal description of precinct boundary lines and those lines as described by census blocks are in conflict, the legal description shall take precedence.
- SECTION 7: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect, following submission and approval of these precinct changes by the Indiana Election Commission, and from and after its passage by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect beginning the \_\_\_\_\_ day of ~~November, 1997~~, and after its enactment and publication as prescribed by law. **FEB. 9, 1998**
