

AMENDED
GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 94-9

COUNTY ROAD SIGN ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under the authority of Indiana Code 8-17-1-1 et, seq, and Indiana Code 9-4-1-1 et. seq. and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that there is a need for the intersection of County Road 800S and County Road 500 W to be changed from a yield to a stop sign. This stop sign would require all traffic on County Road 500W to stop for the intersection of County Road 800 S, making 800S preferential at this intersection with 500W.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the County of Wabash shall be responsible for the placement of the signs.

NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, all traffic on the County roads referred to hereinabove, shall be required to stop at the intersection.

The effect of this Ordinance shall be to make all traffic traveling on County Road 500 W to stop at the intersection with County Road 800 S.

Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction.


