

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 96-2

AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING THE VACATED  
PORTION OF PLATED ALLEYWAY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under the authority of Indiana Code, and all other acts amendatory thereof to the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, after reconsideration, investigation, and for cause find and determine that it would be in the best interest of all residents of Wabash County that the following described previously vacated portion of platted alleyway be rescinded as under General Ordinance # 95-7 and said area be restored to platt;


132 feet alley right of way that separates lots 96 and 97 of the original Comstock Plot (Platt) of Liberty Mills, Wabash County, Indiana.




132 feet alley right of way that separates lots 96 and 97 of the original Comstock Plot (Platt) of Liberty Mills, Wabash County, Indiana.
