GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 94-9

COUNTY ROAD SIGN ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under the authority of Indiana Code 8-17-1-1 et. seq. and Indiana Code 9-4-1-1 et. seq. and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that there is a need for a stop sign placed at the intersection of Tamarack Street, a/k/a 200 W., a/k/a Laketon Road and Wayne Street in Laketon, Indiana. This would make all traffic traveling South on Tamarack Street, a/k/a 200 W., a/k/a Laketon Road stop at Wayne Street making Wayne Street Preferential at this intersection with Tamarack Street, a/k/a 200 W., a/k/a Laketon Road; and


WHEREAS, it has been determined that the County of Wabash shall be responsible for the placement of the sign.


NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the placement of appropriate sign, all traffic on the County roads referred to hereinabove, shall be required to stop at the intersection of Tamarack Street, a/k/a 200 W., a/k/a Laketon Road and Wayne Street in Laketon, Indiana.


The effect of this Ordinance shall be to make all traffic traveling South on Tamarack Street, a/k/a 200 W., a/k/a Laketon Road to stop at Wayne Street.
