

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 95- 2

ORDINANCE AMENDING SHERIFF'S RESERVES

WHEREFORE, in Wabash County Ordinance No. 83-2, there is established a Board of Sheriff's Reserves; and

WHEREAS, it is determined that it would be in the best interest of the County to increase the number of Reserves; and

WHEREAS, this request is brought forth by the Wabash County Sheriff and approved by the Wabash County Commissioners.

NOW THEREFORE, be it Ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County as follows;

Section I

That Ordinance 83-2 as previously passed is hereby made VOID by Amendment as follows.

Section II

The group of Sheriff's Reserve Members established pursuant to Indiana Code 36-8-3-20 known as the Wabash County Sheriff's Reserve Unit shall have a maximum number of members of 20 which are to be paid for their services from the budget of Sheriff's Appropriations. There shall be granted the authority by this ordinance, for additional members, those being either Matrons, Jailers, Dispatchers and/or Process Servers, who are not financially reimbursed for services by this ordinance.

Section III


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and signing by Commissioners.
