

AN ORDINANCE VACATING OF PLATTED ALLEYWAY

Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code 8-20-1-1 et. seq., and all other acts amendatory thereof to the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana after petition, notice and hearing has determined that it would be in the best interest of all residents of Wabash County that the following described portion of platted alleyway be closed and vacated:


The ALLEYWAY off Second Street running East and West between Lots 14 and 15-16. Foust's 2nd Addition to the town of Servia, Wabash County Indiana.


