## GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 94-9

## COUNTY ROAD SIGN ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under the authority of Indiana Code 8-17-1-1 et. seq. and Indiana Code 9-4-1-1 et. seq. and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that there is a need for stop signs to be placed at the intersections of CR 530 W., CR 500 E, CR600 E., and CR 750 E. with the placed at the intersections of those roads with Northfolk and Southern Railway line. This would cause traffic traveling north or south on said road to stop at the railroad crossing; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the County of Wabash shall be responsible for the placement of the signs.

NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, all traffic on the County roads referred to hereinabove, shall be required to stop at the intersection with Northfolk and Southern Railroad, and said traffic shall proceed only at such time as it is safe to do so.

The effect of this Ordinance shall be to make all traffic traveling north and south on the County roads reffered to hereinabove stop at the railroad crossing.

Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction.
