

AN ORDINANCE FOR PARTIAL VACATION OF PLATTED
COUNTY AREA IN MT. VERNON

Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code 8-20-1-1- et. seq., and all other acts amendatory thereof to the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that it would be in the best interest of all residents of Wabash County that the following described portion of platted, but undeveloped area, in Mt. Vernon be vacated:

- A. The platted alley between lots #43 and #44, #45 and #50, #45 and #49, #47 and #48.
- B. The platted alley between lots #45 and #46, and lots #50 and #49.


NOW THEREFORE, on petition filed and approved by all interested and adjoining landowners after due consideration and review, it is determined by said Wabash County Commissioners as signed hereinafter that the following shall be vacated from the plat for the unincorporated town of Mt. Vernon in Wabash County, Indiana, and no longer a part of the dedicated area of said plat.


- A. The platted alley between lots #43, #44, #45, #50, #46, #49, #47 and #48.
- B. The platted alley between lots #45 and #46, and lots #50 and #49.
