

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 91- 9

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A SPEED ZONE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code: 8-17-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code: 9-4-1-1 et seq, and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;


WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that it would be in the best interest of the general public to cause to be established a speed zone on Wabash County Road, known as Wabash Road, from a point at the south edge of the Eel River Bridge to the point where it joins Highway 13, wherein the maximum speed for vehicular traffic would be 40 miles per hour (40 mph);


NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs on those portions of Wabash County Road, known as Wabash Road, from a point at the south edge of the Eel River Bridge to the point where it joins Highway 13, the maximum speed limit shall be 40 miles per hour (40 mph).

Any person who violates any portion of this ordinance shall be guilty of a class "B" misdemeanor.
