

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 6-1991

WABASH COUNTY ORDINANCE RE-DISTRICTING COUNTY

COMMISSIONERS AREA OF DISTRICT REPRESENTATION AND ELECTION

WHEREAS, the County of Wabash, State of Indiana, is divided for governmental and election purposes into three (3) county commissioner districts being known as District 1, 2 and 3; and,

WHEREAS, it is proper and necessary for these commissioner districts to be re-designated and re-apportioned; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of representation and fairness for the areas to be as equal in population as possible; and

WHEREAS, it is proper and correct for such districts to be laid out in such a fashion that they do not divide voter precincts.

NOW, THEREFORE, the County of Wabash, State of Indiana, is by ordinance herein re-districted for county commissioners as set out hereinafter, and all prior ordinances or resolutions of said county enacted prior hereto are revoked and abolished as of the effective date of this ordinance.

County Commissioner District 1 shall include the following:

Pleasant Township
Paw Paw Township
Chester Township voter precinct #1
Chester Township voter precinct #2
Chester Township voter precincts #3, #4, #5 & #6

A color coded map of Wabash County showing commissioner district #1 in blue is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

County Commissioner District 2 shall include the following:

Lagro Township voter precinct #1
Lagro Township voter precinct #2
Lagro Township voter precinct #3
Noble Township voter precinct #3
Noble Township voter precinct #4
Noble Township voter precinct #6
Noble Township voter precinct #8
Noble Township voter precinct #9

district #2 in yellow.

County Commissioner District #3 shall include the following:


- Waltz Township


This Ordinance enacted on unanimous approval of the Wabash County Commissioners as signed hereunder shall become in full force and effect on the 24 day of June, 191991.
