AN ORDINANCE AMENDING GENERAL ORDINANCE 94-9, THE COUNTY ROAD SIGN ORDINANCE, PROVIDING FOR STOP SIGNS ON NORTH OGDEN ROAD AT ITS INTERSECTIONS WITH 200 WEST AND 1050 NORTH

The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, may adopt ordinances regulating traffic on any highway in the county highway system, subject to I.C. 9-21.


The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that it is in the best interests of the citizens of Wabash County to amend General Ordinance 94-9 to provide for motor vehicles traveling north and south on County Road North Ogden Road to stop at its intersections with County Road 200 West and County Road 1050 North.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED THAT GENERAL ORDINANCE 94-9 IS AMENDED TO ADD THE FOLLOWING:


1. Motor vehicles traveling north and south on County Road North Ogden Road shall be required to stop at its intersections with County Road 200 West and County Road 1050 North.
2. The Wabash County Highway Department shall install appropriate signs in accordance with this Ordinance.


