GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 90-5

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE PLACEMENT

OF TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code 8-17-1-1 et. seq. and Indiana Code 9-4-1-1 et. seq. and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that certain traffic control signs should be placed at the intersection of Legacy Court and County Road 550 West (Mill Creek Pike).

NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, all traffic moving from Legacy Court toward the intersection of Legacy Court and County Road 550 West (Mill Creek Pike) will be required to stop, and said traffic shall proceed only at such time as it is safe to do so.

The effect of this Ordinance shall be to cause the traffic approaching from Legacy Court to the intersection of Legacy Court and County Road 550 West to stop before proceeding across or into said intersection.

Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class $^{\circ}$ C $^{\circ}$ infraction.
