

GENERAL ORDINANCE NUMBER 89- VI

AN ORDINANCE FOR VACATING OF PLATTED COUNTY ROADWAY

Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana code 8-20-1-1 et. seq., and all other acts amendatory thereof to the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, have been delivered a petition requesting consideration for vacation of the areas as set out hereinafter by all adjoining and touching land owners, and said Commissioners have determined that it would be in the best interest of public safety and welfare and for the best interest of all residents of Wabash County that the following described portions of platted but undeveloped streets and alleys be vacated;

1. Vacation of Osmer Street in Laketon, Indiana

Osmer Street, just east of Block 5, lot 10
in the town of Laketon, Dan Van Buskirk

2. Vacation of Alley in Block 5 between
Osmer Street and Vaughan Steet

The alley in Block 5 between Osmer Street
and Vaughan Street in the town of Laketon.

3. Vacation of East End of Grafton Street

100 feet at the east end of Grafton Street
in Laketon between lots 4 & 5 in Block 5
and lot 5 & 6 in Block 3, Dan Van Buskirk

Now therefore, it is hereby resolved that the areas as indicated herein are vacated by act of the Wabash County Commissioners on the date as signed hereunder, and shall no longer be a part of the County roadway system, to-wit:

1. Vacation of Osmer Street in Laketon, Indiana

Osmer Street, just east of Block 5, lot 10
in the town of Laketon, Dan Van Buskirk


2. Vacation of Alley in Block 5 between
Osmer Street and Vaughan Steet

The alley in Block 5 between Osmer Street
and Vaughan Street in the town of Laketon.


3. Vacation of East End of Grafton Street

100 feet at the east end of Grafton Street
in Laketon between lots 4 & 5 in Block 5
and lot 5 & 6 in Block 3, Dan Van Buskirk


