GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 85-6

AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING THE COUNTY BOARD OF TAX ADJUSTMENT

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Council of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Public Law #69 passed by the Indiana General Assembly in its session for the year 1985, and all other acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the act as referred to hereinabove allows a County Council to abolish the County Board of Tax Adjustment by adoption of an ordinance by July 1 of any year, rendering and causing the budget, rate, and levy of all units in the county to be reviewed by the State Board of Tax Commission as though they had been approved by the Tax Adjustment Board; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the County Council for Wabash County, Indiana, to exercise the rights under Public Law #69, 1985, and to abolish the County Board of Tax Adjustment.

NOW THEREFORE, from and after the date of signing and enactment of this ordinance, the County Board of Tax Adjustment for Wabash County, Indiana, is hereby abolished, its members released of any further duties, obligations, and responsibilities.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on the date of signing hereunder.
