## GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 85-7

## AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE PLACEMENT OF TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES AND REVOCATION OF ANY PRIOR ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code 8-17-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code 9-4-1-1 et seq, and all other acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that certain traffic control devices should be placed at certain intersections of Wabash County roads as follows, to-wit:

(1) Intersection of Main Street and Second Street in Liberty Mills, Indiana.

WHEREAS, in so doing the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County are specifically and intentionally revoking any sections of prior general ordinances wherein traffic control preferences were previously established at the intersecting roads as mentioned hereinabove.

NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, all traffic at the intersection of Main Street and Second Street in Liberty Mills, Wabash County, Indiana shall be as follows:

(1) Main Street and Second Street in Liberty Mills, Indiana shall be a four-way stop requiring all traffic entering the intersection to come to a full and complete stop before proceding.

The affect of this ordinance makes the intersection of Main Street and Second Street in Liberty Mills, Indiana a four-way stop, no street being preferential and all vehicles entering the intersection being required to stop before proceeding.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the erection of appropriate signs at the location as described herein.

Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class C infraction and shall be penalized appropriately. Any and all fines collected under this ordinance shall be deposited into the General Fund of Wabash County, Indiana under Indiana Code I.C. 9-4-1-27.
