GENERAL ORDINANCE # 9 - 1984

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ENFORCEMENT OF VIOLATIONS OF THE COUNTY HEALTH ORDINANCE

WHEREAS the County Commissioners have deemed it necessary to provide a method for citing of violations of County Health Ordinances;

WHEREAS they hereby incorporate the form of information and summonses referred to in IC 9-4-7-4;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the County Commissioners of Wabash County as follows:

- 1. "Offense" means any violation of an ordinance or regulation concerning public health or safety.
- 2. "The Court" means any tribunal with jurisdiction to hear and determine violations of County Ordinance and the Judge, or other presiding officer thereof as sitting as a Court.
- 3. "Judge" included any officer authorized by law to sit as a Court to which this chapter applies.
 - 4. "Oaths" included affirmations.
- 5. "Officer" means any law enforcement officer, health officer, or employee or agent to the Health Officer of Wabash County.
- 5. "Complaint and Summons" means any complaint or summons which substantially complies with IC 9-4-7-4.

Upon the issuance of a complaint and summons by an officer the person shall appear in a Court where the summons and complaint direct him to appear. Failure to appear as directed shall be a Class "C" Infraction.
