

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 82-5A

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING
MAXIMUM HEIGHT LIMITATION

BE IT ORDAINED by The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code: 8-17-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code: 9-4-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code: 17-2-2.5-1 et seq, and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREFORE, The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that a maximum height limitation should be placed upon Wabash County Bridge #009, situated on Carroll Street crossing the Wabash River,

NOW THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, the maximum height of vehicles using the Wabash County Bridge #009, located on Carroll Street crossing the Wabash River shall not exceed eight feet six inches (8' 6").

Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in any sum not exceeding 1200⁰⁰, to which may be added imprisonment in the County Jail for a period of not more than 90 days.
