

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 81-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ESTABLISHED

MAXIMUM HEIGHT AND WEIGHT LIMITATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED by The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code: 8-17-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code: 9-4-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code: 17-2-2.5-1 et seq, and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;




WHEREFORE, The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that it is in the best interest of safety that the maximum height limitation placed upon the covered bridge on Singer Road in the Town of North Manchester, Indiana, in General Ordinance No.80-1 passed on the 25th day February, 1980, be amended to reduce said height limitation from eight feet nine inches (8'9") to seven feet (7'), leaving the gross weight of vehicles using the covered bridge on Singer Road in the Town of North Manchester, Indiana at the previously established weight limit of three (3) tons.

NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, the height of vehicles using the covered bridge on Singer Road in the Town of North Manchester, Indiana, shall not exceed seven feet (7'), nor shall the gross weight of vehicles using the covered bridge on Singer Road in the Town of North Manchester, Indiana, exceed the weight of three (3) tons.

Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in any sum not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), to which may be added imprisonment in the County Jail for a period of not more than ten (10) days.
