

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 81-2

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE PLACEMENT

TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code 8-17-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code 9-4-1-1 et seq, and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that certain traffic control signs should be placed on Wabash County Roads 200 N and 300 E and at the three-way intersection of said Roads 200 N and 300 E.


NOW THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, all traffic moving toward the three-way intersection will be required to stop at the intersection of said County Roads 200 N and 300 E, and said traffic shall proceed only at such time as it is safe to do so.

The effect of this Ordinance shall be to create a three-way stop causing all traffic approaching the intersection of Wabash County Roads 200 N and 300 E to stop before proceeding across or into said intersection.


Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction.

PASSED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, this 30<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1981.


