

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 80-4

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING  
MAXIMUM WEIGHT LIMITATION

BE IT ORDAINED by The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code: 8-17-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code: 9-4-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code: 17-2-2.5-1 et seq, and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREFORE, The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that a maximum weight limitation should be placed upon Wabash County Roads 100 East and 100 North;

Because the roads are being torn up by the overweight trucks there is an emergency existing; and

NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, the gross weight of vehicles using Wabash County Roads 100 East and 100 North shall not exceed ten tons.

Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in any sum not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), to which may be added imprisonment in the County Jail for a period of not more than ten (10) days.
