

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 77-3

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE PLACEMENT
OF TRAFFIC-CONTROLLED DEVICES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code: 8-17-1-1, et. seq., and Indiana Code: 9-4-1-1, et. seq., and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that certain additional traffic-controlled devices should be placed at the intersection of Wabash County Roads 200 West and 400 North,

NOW THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, traffic moving in a northerly or southerly direction on County Road 200 West shall be required to stop at the intersection of said County Road 200 West with County Road 400 North, and said traffic shall proceed only at such time as it is safe to do so. Traffic moving in an easterly or westerly direction on County Road 400 North shall be required to stop at the intersection of said County Road 400 North with County Road 200 West, and said traffic shall proceed only at such time as it is safe to do so.

The effect of this Ordinance shall be to create a four-way stop at the above described intersection.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the erection of appropriate signs at the locations described herein.

Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in any sum not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), to
