

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 77-4

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE
INJURY OR REMOVAL OF SECTION
CORNER REFERENCE MARKERS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code: 17-2-2.5-1:

It shall be unlawful for any person to willfully or maliciously damage, disfigure, displace, deface, obliterate, mutilate, mar, remove, injure or destroy any section corner reference marker placed by or under the authority of the Surveyor of Wabash County.

Any person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).
