

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 76- I-B
AN ORDINANCE CREATING STOP
INTERSECTIONS AND DIRECTING
PLACEMENT OF STOP SIGNS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Chapter 112, Acts of 1919; Chapter 48, Acts of 1939; Chapter 48, Acts of 1947; and Chapter 38, Acts of 1947, and all Acts amendatory thereto, General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that certain traffic control devices need to be placed at the intersection of County Road 500 North and 800 East, and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that certain traffic control devices need to be placed at intersection of County Road 250 South and 600 East,

NOW THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, traffic moving in a southerly or northerly direction on County Road 800 East shall be required to stop at the intersection of said County Road 800 East with County Road 500 North and said traffic shall proceed only at such time as it is safe to do so.

Further, traffic moving in an easterly or westerly direction on County Road 500 North shall be required to stop at the intersection of said County Road 500 North with County Road 800 East and said traffic shall proceed only at such time as it is safe to do so.

Further, traffic moving in an easterly or westerly direction on County Road 250 South shall be required to stop at the intersection of said County Road 250 South with County Road 600 East and said traffic shall proceed only at such time as it is safe to do so.

Further, traffic moving in a northerly direction on County Road 600 East shall be required to stop at the intersection of said County Road 600 East with County Road 250 South and said traffic shall proceed only at such time as it is safe to do so.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the erection of stop signs at all corners at said locations described herein.

If a part of this Ordinance is invalid, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid part shall remain in full force and effect.
