

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 9, 1968

AN ORDINANCE CREATING STOP  
INTERSECTIONS AND DIRECTING  
PLACEMENT OF STOP SIGNS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Chapter 112, Acts of 1919, Chapter 48, Acts of 1939, Chapter 48, Acts of 1947, and Chapter 338, Acts of 1947, and all Acts amendatory thereto, General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has caused a survey to be made with regard to the speed limit and traffic control devices on certain highways within Wabash County, Indiana, and

WHEREAS, the report of such survey is on file with the Board of County Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana,

NOW THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, the intersection of County Road 600E and Wabash County Road 500S in the Town of Lincolnville shall be a four-way stop intersection and all vehicles before entering said intersection shall stop and proceed only at such time as it is safe to do so; vehicles upon and along Bruner Road shall stop before entering Road 350E and proceed into the intersection of said Bruner Road and said Road 350E only at such time as it is safe to do so;

vehicles upon and along America Road shall stop before entering Road 1200S and shall proceed into the intersection of said America Road and said Road 1200S only when it is safe to do so.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the erection of stop signs at said locations.

If a part of this Ordinance is invalid, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect.
