- b. On page 20 of the Master Plan and Zoning Ordinance in Agricultural and Forest Reserve areas, the minimum lot size requirement for two-family dwellings is hereby changed from 90,000 square feet to 40,000 square feet.
- c. On page 20 of the Master Plan and Zoning Ordinance in Lake Residential areas, the minimum lot size requirement for single-family dwellings is hereby changed from 40,000 square feet to 10,000 square feet.
